The above named Order, made on the 9th day of October 1981 is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation, or to be confirmed as an unopposed Order by the Hampshire County Council.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modification, will be to divert the public right of way described in Part I of the Schedule hereto to the route described in Part II of the Schedule.

Copies of the Order and Map contained in it have been deposited at the office of the Secretary and Solicitor, Test Valley Borough Council, Beech Hurst, Weyhill Road, Andover at Braishfield Post Office, Braishfield and at the office of the undersigned, where they may be inspected free of charge during the normal office hours.

If you wish to have sent to you in due course a notice to the effect that the Order has been confirmed, and a copy of the Order as confirmed, you should write to the undersigned giving your name and address to which these documents may be sent.

Compensation for depreciation or damage in consequence of the coming into operation of the Order is payable in accordance with Section 121 (2) of the Highways Act, 1980, to which reference should be made.

Any representation or objection with respect to the Order may be sent in writing to the undersigned before 20th November 1981 and should state the grounds on which it is made.

If no representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, the Hampshire County Council may instead of submitting the Order to the Secretary of State for the Environment, themselves confirm the Order. If the Order is submitted to the Secretary of State any objections and representations which have been duly made and not withdrawn will be transmitted with the Order.

SCHEDULE

PART I

Description of Site of Existing Path

That part of the Footpath in the Parish of Braishfield in the Borough of Test Valley shown on the Definitive Map of Public Rights of Way prepared under Part IV of the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949, as Footpath No. 8, which commences at a junction with Road U65 and runs southeastwards for approximately 168 metres.

PART II

Description of Site of Alternative Highway

A 1.8 metre wide grass and earth headland path which commences at the northern end of the path described in Part I of this Schedule and runs southwestwards on the east side of a hedge for approximately 52 metres then continuing south-southwestwards for approximately 112 metres then runs east-southeastwards on the south side of a hedge for approximately 84 metres then continuing eastwards for approximately 110 metres. A total distance of approximately 358 metres.
