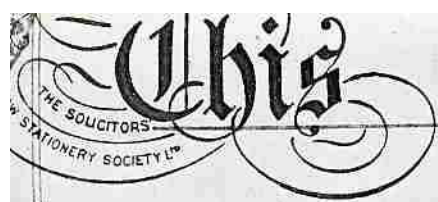

D E E D is made the Twenty ninth  
day of September One thousand nine hundred

and fifty five B E T W E E N JOHN ERNEST HODDINOTT of Elm Grove  
Braishfield in the County of Southampton Farmer DOROTHY CECILY LAVINIA  
BACON of Orchard Cottage, Braishfield aforesaid Spinster and BERTIE  
ALFRED ROSS of South View Cottage Braishfield aforesaid Builder  
(hereinafter called "the Grantors") of the one part and THE COUNTY  
COUNCIL of the COUNTY OF SOUTHAMPTON (hereinafter called "the Council")  
of the other part \_\_\_\_\_

W H E R E A S :

(1) The Grantors are seised in fee simple as joint tenants of the land  
situate at Braishfield in the County of Southampton and known as The  
Braishfield Recreation Ground part of which said land is delineated on  
the plan annexed hereto and thereon marked "Recreation Ground" and  
coloured pink \_\_\_\_\_

(2) The Council are desirous of laying constructing and maintaining in  
or under the said land the sewer and manhole hereinafter mentioned and  
the Grantors in consideration of the payment of Five Pounds have agreed  
to execute such grant as is hereinafter contained \_\_\_\_\_

N O W   T H I S   D E E D   W I T N E S S E T H as follows:-

1. In consideration of the sum of FIVE POUNDS paid by the Council  
to the Grantors (the receipt whereof the Grantors hereby acknowledge)  
the Grantors as Trustees in exercise of every power enabling them  
hereby grant unto the Council full and free right liberty and power to  
lay construct and maintain in or under the said land in a position  
shewn by the blue lines between the points marked 'A' and 'B' on the  
said plan a line of pipes for the passage of sewage (hereinafter called  
"the sewer") four inches in diameter and laid at a depth of approximately  
six feet six inches and at all times hereafter to enter upon the said  
land for the purpose of repairing inspecting renewing cleansing and  
maintaining the said sewer but not for any other purpose TO HOLD the  
said right and liberty unto the Council their successors and assigns  
in fee simple subject to the covenants and conditions hereinafter  
contained \_\_\_\_\_

(b) To leave the said land in a level and tidy state to enable the Grantors to make good the surface if necessary \_\_\_\_\_

(c) To be responsible for any damage the Council may cause to the said land due to subsequent maintenance or repair of the sewer \_\_\_\_\_

3. The Grantors hereby acknowledge the right of the Council to production of the documents specified in the Schedule hereto and to delivery of copies thereof. \_\_\_\_\_

4. It is hereby certified that the transaction hereby effected does not form part of a larger transaction or of a series of transactions in respect of which the amount or value or the aggregate amount or value of the consideration exceeds Five Hundred Pounds. \_\_\_\_\_

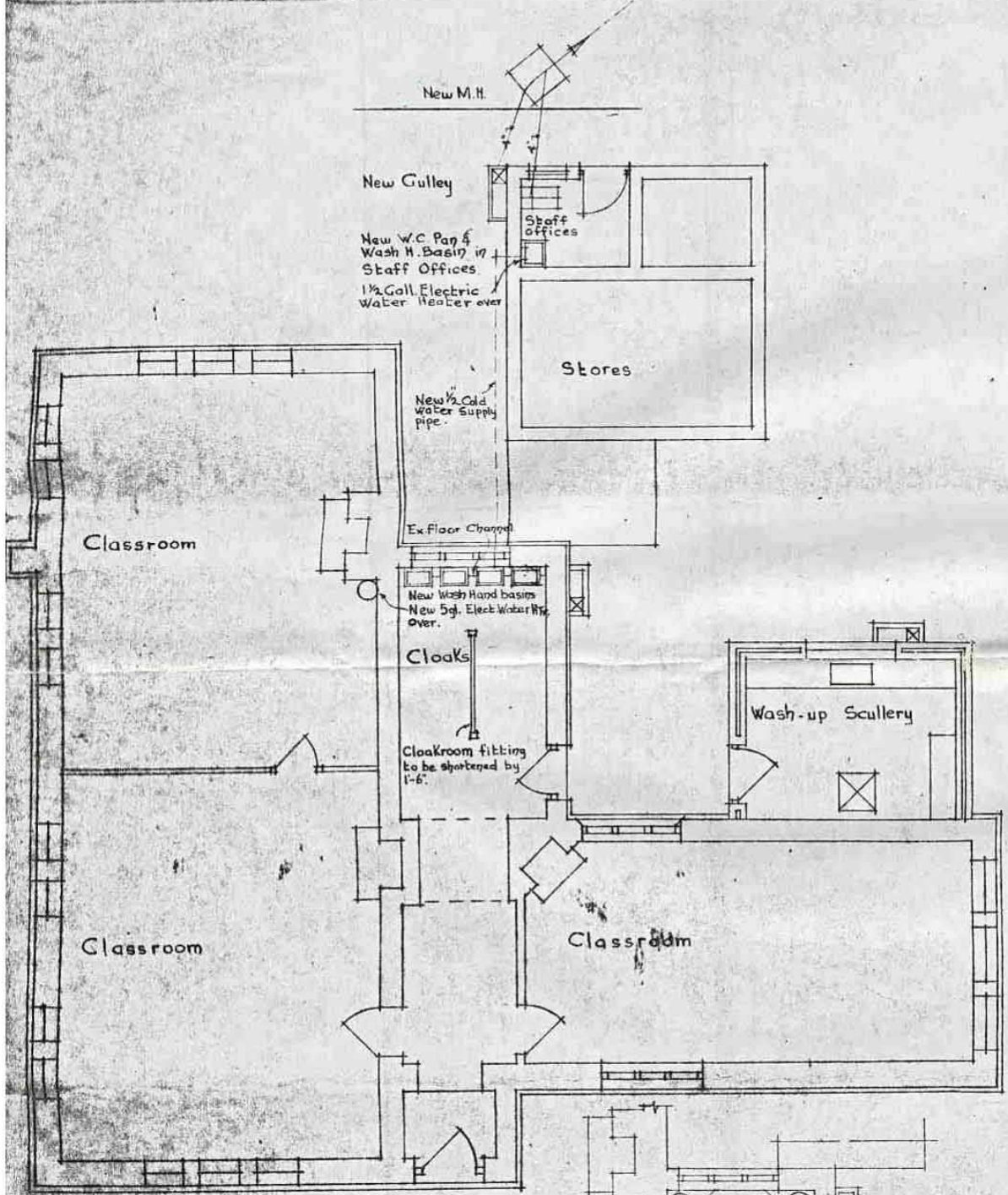
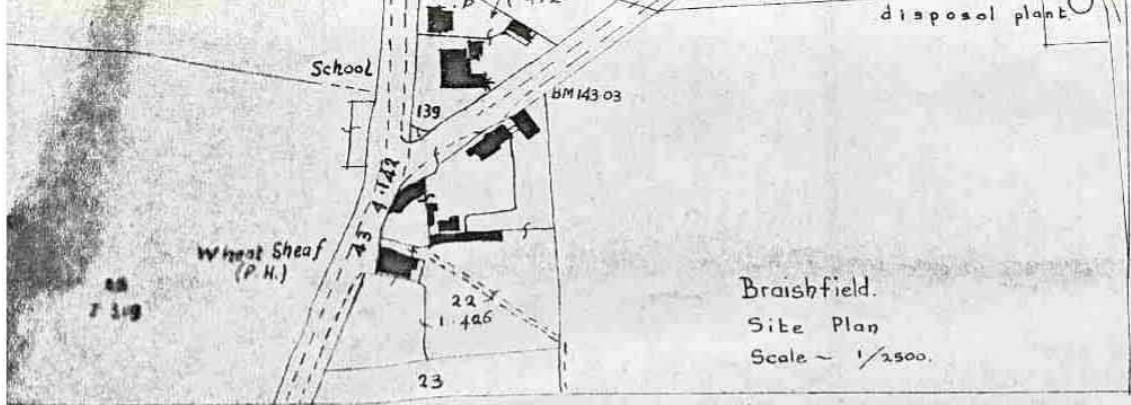

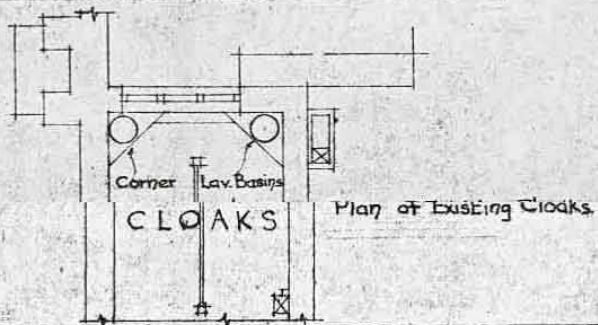

Scales 20 & 8 FEET To 1 INCH.

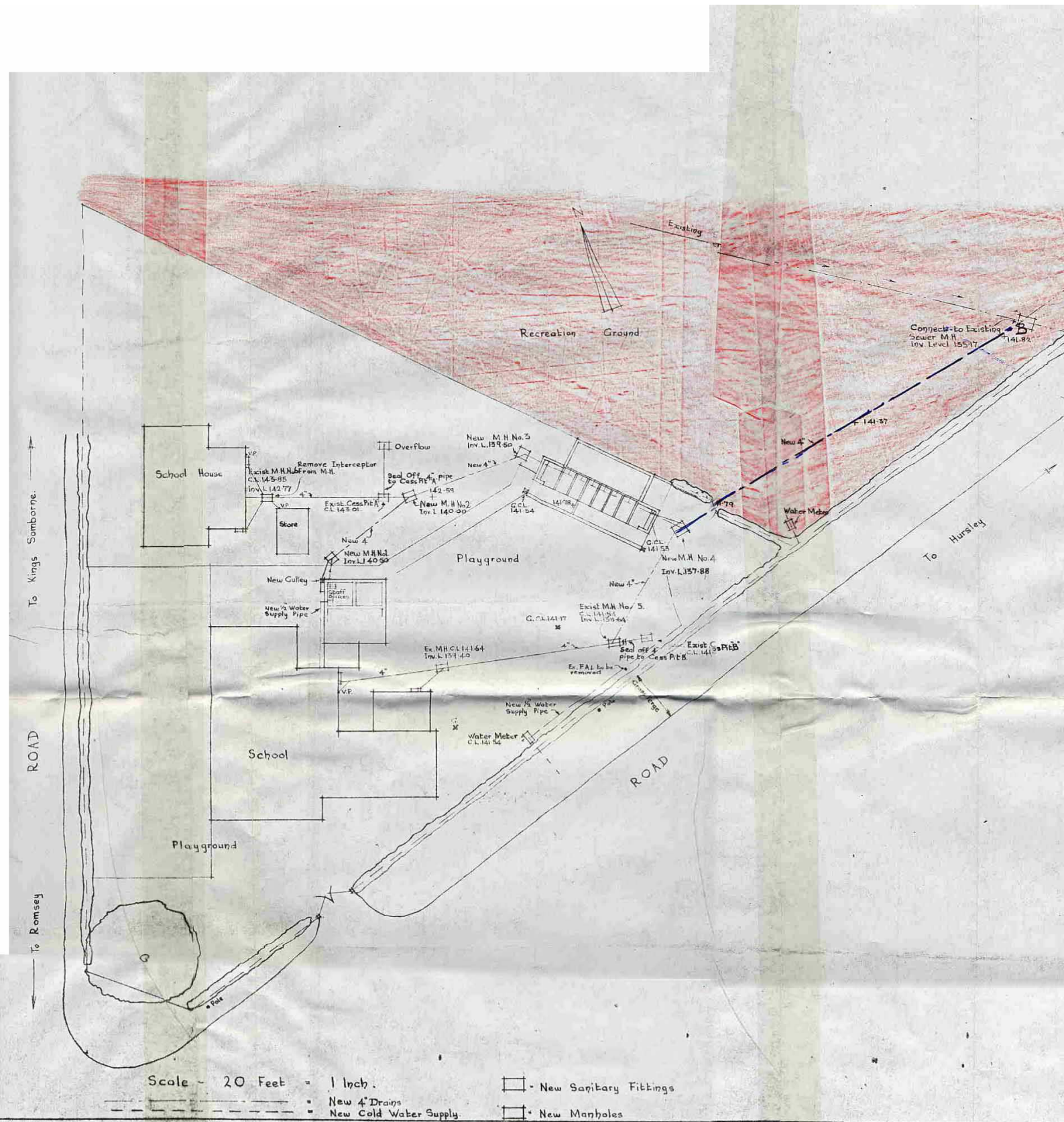

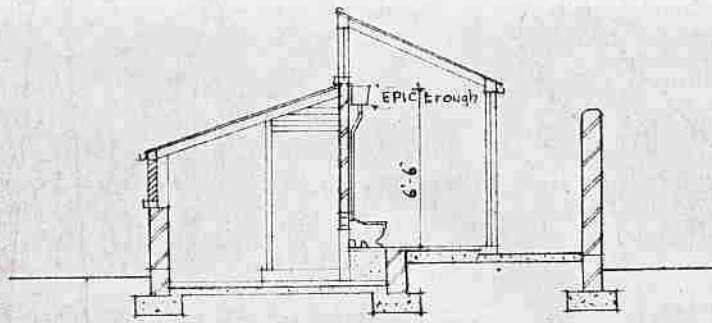

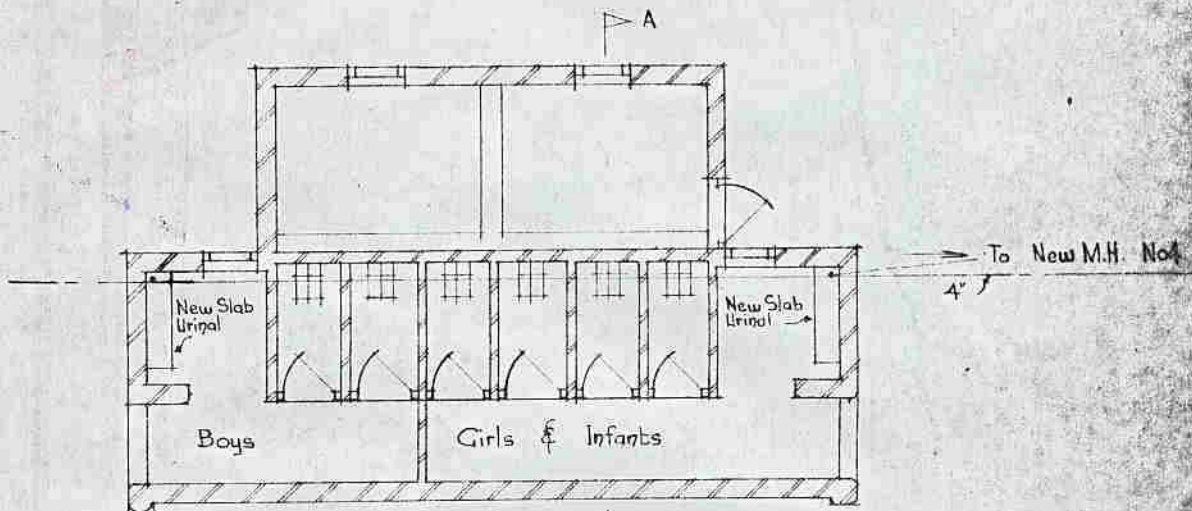
CONVERSION OF EXISTING CLOSETS



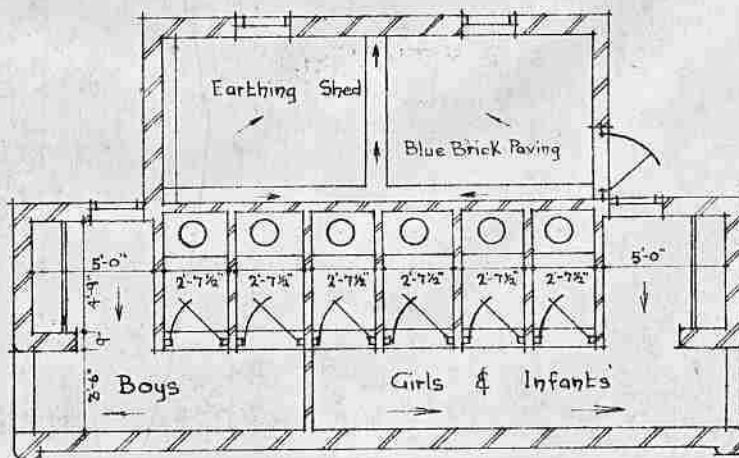
RY TO SCHOOL WATERBORNE SANITATION AND CONNECTION TO SEWER.
