In pursuance of their powers under the above-mentioned Act and Regulations, the Council, as the local planning authority, CONSENT to:

Crown lift bottom branches 5 x Sycamore & 5 Norway Maples. Prune 3 x Beech around floodlights. Crown lift 3 x Limes up to 4m. Prune 1 x Copper Beech in recreation ground overhanging shed at primary school.

Recreation Ground, BRAISHFIELD

in accordance with the plans and particulars submitted with your application received on 03/11/97, subject to compliance with the conditions specified below:

1. The crown lifting of those trees overhanging the football pitch, shall be limited to the removal of those branches growing over or towards the pitch only.
(Reason: In the interests of good arboricultural practice and the visual amenities of the area.)

Notes:

1. All works shall be carried out in accordance with BS.3998, in the interests of good arboricultural practice.
2. You are advised to arrange for the works to be carried out by a qualified, competent tree surgeon.
