This Deed OF APPOINTMENT is made the sixth day of September One thousand nine hundred and forty five Between ADMIRAL SIR REGINALD HUGH SPENCER BACON K.C.V.O., D.S.O., J.P., of Braishfield Lodge near Romsey in the County of Southampton and WILLIAM GLADSTONE OWEN of Elm Grove Braishfield aforesaid of the one part and JOHN ERNEST HODDINOTT of Elm Grove Braishfield aforesaid Farmer and DOROTHY CICELY LAVINIA BACON of Braishfield Lodge aforesaid Spinster of the other part SUPPLEMENTAL to a Conveyance dated the Twenty seventh day of November One thousand nine hundred and twenty two and made between Alfred Charles King of the one part and the said Reginald Hugh Spencer Bacon William Gladstone Owen and Alfred Charles King of the other part by which certain property now known as The Braishfield Recreation Ground was conveyed by the said Alfred Charles King to the said Reginald Hugh Spencer Bacon and William Gladstone Owen and their heirs to the use of the said Reginald Hugh Spencer Bacon and William Gladstone Owen and Alfred Charles King in fee simple Upon trust to preserve the same subject to the provisions contained in the said Conveyance Whereas the said Alfred Charles King died on the eleventh day of January One thousand nine hundred and thirty five And WHEREAS the said Reginald Hugh Spencer Bacon and William Gladstone Owen are desirous of appointing the said John Ernest Hoddinott and Dorothy Cicely Lavinia Bacon to be Trustees of the said Conveyance and of The Braishfield Recreation Ground jointly with them the said Reginald Hugh Spencer Bacon and William Gladstone Owen Now THIS DEED Witnesseth that the said Reginald Hugh Spencer Bacon and William Gladstone Owen in exercise of the power given to them by the Trustees Act 1925 and of every other power them hereunto enabling hereby appoint the said John Ernest Hoddinott and Dorothy Cicely Lavinia Bacon to be Trustees of the said Conveyance and of The Braishfield Recreation Ground jointly with them the said Reginald Hugh Spencer Bacon and William Gladstone Owen AND THIS Deed ALSO Witnesseth that in pursuance of the appointment hereinbefore contained the said Reginald Hugh Spencer Bacon and William Gladstone Owen hereby declare that all the property and chattels and the right to recover and receive all debts and other things in action subject to the trusts of the said Conveyance shall forthwith vest in the said Reginald Hugh Spencer Bacon William Gladstone Owen John Ernest Hoddinott and Dorothy Cicely Lavinia Bacon according to the respective natures of such trust property respectively as Trustees of the said Conveyance and of The Braishfield Recreation Ground as joint tenants for the purposes and upon the trusts thereof so far as the same are now subsisting and capable of taking effect.
