Minutes. Minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed.

Correspondence. Receipt of letters from the Roney & Stoughton Rural District Council with regard to the proposed Relief Association. The Clerk was directed to reply thereto.

Alcohol. Statistics. Receipt of letters from the Roney & Stoughton R.D.C. with regard to alcohol and United Nations Day 1953.

Housing. The Clerk produced 31 Housing Applications for houses in the Parish. The Chairman stated that the Rural District Council representatives thought it best to defer the consideration of these applications until near the completion of the houses which is estimated for February 1954. It was agreed that consideration be postponed and if necessary a special meeting be called for the purpose.

General Vacancy. Discussion on filling the vacant ^{vacancy} school place and suggestions made. The Chairman agreed to ask Mr Brown if he would consent to be nominated.

Post Office. It was agreed to ask the Rural District Council to support the Council in obtaining a post box at the Women's Institute.

Education:

The Clerk produced a letter from the County Education Officer with regard to the erection of new Secondary School in Housey & provide additional Secondary School places. The Clerk was directed to acknowledge the letter and to express the hope that steps would be taken to erect the new school.
