It was also resolved to make a Precept on the Romsey & Stockbridge Rural District Council of £16.

The Chairman reported on the enquiry held with regard to the Dark Lane Footpath.

Questions were raised with regard to the New Valuation List and the Clerk was directed to write to the District Council to ask if the Valuation List could be on view at the Annual Parish Meeting on 26th March.

The Chairman asked who was to make the report to the Annual Meeting.

It was agreed that the clerk should make the report.

Footpaths. The clerk was directed to report to the Divisional Surveyor with regard to the following footpaths:—

No 25. That the public were exercising horses and riding bicycles on this path so that the surface is becoming unusable.

No 22. That this footpath had been ploughed to the verge of the field making it difficult to use.

No 26. That there were no steps on the stile on this path.

Bus Shelter. The club reported thereon and discussion took place on the fixing of the Commemorative Plaque. The clerk promised to see Mr Bailey and get the Plaque fixed.

Dangerous Well. Mr Parson stated that there was a dangerous well at Church View Drive. The clerk was directed to report the existence of this well to the District Council informing them that it had been repaired by the Council in the past.
