the District Council and state that

land ran across the site and  
that access from the adjoining  
road would not be very satisfactory  
owing to the narrow road.

The Clerk was also to draw attention  
to the difficulty of drainage and  
that any overflow from a cesspit  
would pollute the stream at the  
bottom of the site which ran into  
the pond.

W. Holtold raise the question of the  
condition of the road and drainage  
near Bramshelm Lodge and

Bowling Green. The letter was directed  
to ask the surveyor if he would meet  
Mr. Foltz on the site.
