

Minutes of the Annual Meeting of the Council

Mr. Bobbold and Mr. Parsons were elected

It was reported that the latched drain on Crossbrook Common was a public nuisance because of the smell and smoke. The Clerk was to report the complaint to the District Council and ask that the nuisance be dealt with.

Matters.

It was agreed that Mr. Kothold and Mrs. Bacon be representatives appointed by the Council as School Managers for the Britishfield Primary School, and that the Clerk should communicate with Mr. Greenwood on the matter.

Bus Service

The Clerk read a letter from the Karts & Dorset Bus Company stating that the service would be extended to the school from Monday to Saturday on journeys 9.25, 11.25 am, 1.25, & 4.35 pm. As the 4.35 was being retarded to 4.35 in order to allow for an additional journey at 4.05 pm from Bournemouth to the school to cater for school children.
