Minutes

Minutes of the last meeting were read
and confirmed.

Correspondence

The Clerk reported receipt of a letter
from the Clerk to the District Council
stating that the Council application
for the use of the site behind the
Post Office for Old People's Buildings
would be placed before the appropriate
Committee when consideration is
given to the Council's future building
programme.

Receipt of letters from the Health
Department stating that in future
refuse collection would be
fortnightly commencing on the 8th
January.

Business

On the proposition of Miss Gordon seconded
by Mr Jones it was resolved that
the name of the Council be changed
from Personal Injuries whilst on
duty to the sum of £2,500 at the
premium of 2/3 per mille per annum
with the British Council Association.

It was agreed now that the New Hedge
at Brackfield hedge had been
cut to ask the Overseer to order
to clear the road surface from the
The Old Barn to W. Colbolds shop.

Michelmersh
Chalk pit

The Clerk reported on the condition
of the chalk pit at home Brook
from which the Parishioners of Brackfield
had the right to dig and take away
chalk. It was agreed to support
the Michelmersh Council in this matter.

Berkshire

The Clerk reported that he had
received from Mrs. Bacon a petition
signed by 116 Parishioners and others
that she had received from one of
the bus drivers asking for a Sunday
service. On the instructions of the
Clerkman he had been in touch
with the Traffic Superintendent.
This officer stated there was little
likelihood of consideration being
given to a Sunday service until the
increase of one man operation in the
Southampton area.

The Clerk was directed to send the
petition to the Traffic Superintendent
and explain the Council's position on
the matter and how the petition was
organised and came into the Council's
possession.

Low Bridge

The Clerk was directed to draw the

attention of the County Surveyor to
the width of Brook Bridge and ask
for his objection thereon.

The Clerk was to ask Mr. Massachusetts
to cut the remaining portion of his hedge
and to draw the attention of the
District Surveyor to the condition
of the Standard Sign Post.
