on Monday the 31st August 1959 8p

Minutes of the last meeting were  
read and confirmed.

Coming from the minutes Mr Brown  
stated that it was hoped the  
building of the dwellings on the Post  
Office and Chapel sites would be  
commenced shortly and that  
Mr Osman the Council's second  
choice had been allotted the  
vacant Council House.

After discussion it was resolved on  
the proposition of Mr Willelt seconded  
by Mr Francis that Mr Fielder at the  
the Recreation hedge for the sum  
of £10 -

The Clerk reported that he had been  
in communication with the County  
Surveyor with regard to one of his  
representatives attending a meeting of  
the Council to explain the County  
Council policy with regard to  
such paths and that he had

invited such representative to attend the next meeting. The action of the Board was approved.

The Chairman read a letter he had received from the Chairman of the County District Council with regard to World Refugee Year Appeal. The Chairman stated and it was agreed that the matter should be dealt with as a village and that a meeting of the various organisations in the parish should be called.

Mrs Bacon undertook to call the meeting for October the 12th at the ~~County District Council~~ <sup>County District Council</sup> and she would invite two members of the Organisation to Bostold and Mr. Parsons were appointed representatives of the Parish Council.

The Chairman stated he would report to the Chairman of the District Council.

Mr. Brown reported with regard to the development of land opposite the schoolhouse.

Mr. Brown also reported that the Hill View cottage were to be demolished.
