

Minutes of a meeting of the Council held at the Social Club Bushfield on Tuesday the 7th December 1959 at 8pm present:-

Minutes of the last meeting were read and confirmed.

Apology was received from Mrs Davis.

The Clerk reported he had obtained the necessary maps to make a map of the Parish. It was agreed that the cost of the maps amounting to 17/- be paid.

W. Parsons reported that the hedge round the Recreation Ground had been cut and a cheque for £10 had been paid to W. Fielder. This was approved.

Boundaries
 Parish

The Chairman raised the question of the boundaries of the Parish particularly with regard to Nuttall Farm and Seaford Farm and after discussion it was agreed that the Clerk should communicate with the County Council thereon.

Footpaths

W Bobbold raised the question of the overgrown footpath No 9 and the Clerk agreed to see Mr Ollivant and ask him to cut back the hedge.

Mr Travis reported that six boxes of glass in the bus shelter had been broken. After discussion it was agreed that the lights in both sides of the shelter be removed and Mr Travis agreed to do this.

The question of the flooding of the road in the Parish was discussed and the Clerk was directed to communicate with the District Surveyor, Deveson particularly with regard to the road by the hedge and the Pond. It was agreed to put the matter of the roads on the agenda for the next meeting.

Mr Travis stated that the Social Club desired to make the entrance to the Club premises more accessible. It was agreed that permission be granted.

Mr Brown stated that the appeal against the Planning authorities refusal to allow the land opposite the Wheelstep to be used for building would be heard at the High Officers Court Road Bovey on Wednesday the 20th December at 10 am. After discussion the Clerk was directed to write two letters to represent the Parish Council at the appeal and to support the refusal to allow this land for building.

The Chairman reported his views with regard to cancelling the meeting of 2nd December.
