Correspondence

The Club reported letters from Mr R. E. M.
confirming his estimate of £10.15.0 for cutting the
Trees in the Recreation and from Mr G. Gifford
of Sevenside offering to do this work for £5
The offer of Mr G. Gifford was accepted.

The Club reported that Footpath No 9 had
now been dealt with.

The Club also reported that the drainage at the
War Memorial had been dealt with.

The Club also stated that the estate at
Cherry Hill had received planning permission
and that the District Surveyor was unable to
take any action with regard to the ditch
adjoining Mr Stearn's property.

Bar Service

The Bar & Social Hotel Stearn's Ltd. stated
that the 10.10 pm service would be extended
to Brackfield Road as from the
3rd February. The Club was invited
to express the thanks of the Council to the

Traffic Manager for his help and cooperation.

Library Service

The Librarian read a letter from the Society Librarian with regard to this service. It was agreed to suggest that the Women's Institute would be a suitable stopping place.

Deliveries

The Librarian read a letter from the Post Office regarding the delivery of mail. He was unable to give a firm date for the introduction of the service but the proposals were in an advanced stage and the Council would be notified as soon as the date was known.

Mr Brown reported on the application of Mr Swann with regard to his workshop in Telford Lane and that a viewing committee would be visiting the site. It was agreed to raise no objection to this application.
