Minutes of a meeting of the Council held at the
Sonal Club Braintree on Monday the 5th
November 1962 at 8pm Present:-

The Chairman welcomed Mr. Hoddenott to
the Council and Mr. Hoddenott replied
thanking the Chairman for his good wishes.

Minutes of the last meeting were read and
confirmed.

It was reported that the water ditch from Howe's
Street to Lamerbrook Common had not been
reinstated and that the property to which the
water had been laid had now been sold. The
Cllr was decided to ask the Council Surveyor
to see that the owner of the property fulfil his
obligations to reinstate the trench.

Mr. Travis ^{offer £200} was prepared to cut the hedge
at the Recreation Ground for the sum of £10.
It was agreed to accept the offer to cut the
hedge at this price.

Bridle Path. The question of the Bridle Path No 11
was raised and the Cllr agreed to see the
Council thereon.

Mr. Parson proposed that the Clapnet had
taken down from the Bus shelter because it
had been defaced. It was agreed that Mr. Parson

should be entrusted with having the League
reconditioned

The Club read a letter from the Ministry of
Education stating that the Brierfield Recreation
Ground had been covered in the Regrowth of Land Act
under the Charities Act 1960. The Club was
directed to inform the Football Club of their
registration
