

Minutes of a meeting of the Annual held at the Social Club Brighthelm on Monday the 4th June 1963 at 8pm present: -

Speed Limit. The Clerk read a letter from the Districtal Surveyor stating that Brighthelm Village is not a place which the County Council would recommend for a speed limit. It was agreed to take no further action.

Petrol Station. The Council inspected the Landfill and it was agreed that an Estimate be obtained for a Boundary Post and wire fence (2 Strand). Regret was expressed that the trees were gone and hope was expressed that something would be done to redress it.

Correspondence. A letter was received from the Karts & Dorset Motor Services stating that application was being made for

an increase in fares owing to the recent increase in wages.

A letter was received from Ed Long protesting against the erection of a new club at Brown Hill. It was agreed that the letter be sent to the District Council.
