The Chairman read a letter from H. Roddewell
stating that owing to ill health he had not offered
himself for reelection to the Council. The

Thanks of the Council for his past services had been expressed to Mr. Haddenell.

Receipt of a letter from the Heads Postmaster Southampton asking the Council view on the closing of Bushfield Post Office at 5.30 P.M. on Saturday instead of 6 P.M. It was agreed to raise no objection to this change.

Receipt of letter from the P. Council Assoc. with Agents of Annual Meeting on July 4th. The representatives agreed to attend.

Receipt of letter from Rep. P. Council Assoc. that a meeting of representatives would be held on Wednesday the 17 June at Kowey. The representatives and the Chairman agreed to attend.

In answer the Club reported with regard to Public Liability & Passengers Insurance it was agreed that these two items be covered with the Ocean Accident & Guarantee Corp. Ltd. at a cost of £2,140.

The Club reported that Mr. Old had commenced work on the Recreation Ground as per tender.

Mr. Tinsley reported on the condition of the Bios Shell and the Council expressed concern and deplores the damage proposedly caused out what has wrecked the Shell.

Mr Parsons stated that the plaque had been
rewritten and he was asked to bring this to the
next meeting.

It was reported that the work on Proctor Hill
water had been commenced.

The Chairman spoke of the frequent failures in
the Electricity supply and he was asked
to see the Southern Electricity Board thereon.

The question of the width of the road from
the Church Hill to the Pond was raised and
it was agreed to refer this to the District
Surveyor.
