

Minutes of a meeting of the Council held at
the Council Club Busfield on Monday 7th

opposite the Post Office.

The Clerk was directed to write to the District
Surveyor with regard to passing fence in Church
Lane and Kila Lane, and the Footpath from the Boy's
Brook to the Bleatoleaf suggesting that boneroll slabs be
placed over the drainage gutters.

It was agreed to place the Recreation Ground on the
agenda for the next meeting to be held on 14th January 1965.
