was received and a cheque drawn and

Arising out of this the Clerk was directed
to write to the Playing Field Superintendent
informing him that work had been
carried out and to ask that the part of the
Playing Field he enclosed in the
Salary drawing in future

A letter was read from Mr Baker
a cheque was sent with regard to footfalls
and the Clerk was directed to write

to the owners asking them to make the paths
accessible to the Public

The Clerk read a letter from the Clerk of the
County Council calling a meeting of representatives
of Parish Councils. Mr Parsons agreed to
attend this meeting

Attention was drawn to the deplorable state
of the Tootall Flat in the Recreation Ground
The Clerk was asked to write to Mr. Byrne
thereon

It was agreed to erect 2 concrete posts
in the opening on Common Hill Road so as
to prevent vehicles entering the Recreation
Ground, and to put some gravel in
the entrance to the Ground. Mr Parsons
agreed to deal with these matters.
