

Minutes of a meeting of the Council held

Minutes of the last meeting were read and
confirmed.

Mr. Parsons reported on the Recreation
Ground and it was agreed that he should
obtain a quantity of gravel to fill the
holes in the entrance of the Playing Field.
Now that the bottom part of the Recreation had
been tidied up it was agreed to ask the
Playing Field Superintendents to cut this part
of the Ground.

Mr. Parsons also reported that the old Football
Kut had been removed.

It was agreed that the Clerk should send copies
of the papers not to Mr. Olcott & Mr. Hubblewhite.

The Clerk reported that he had again
received £25 from the County Council
for use of the Playing field for the Broughfield
School.

Receipt of a letter from the County Surveyor
stating that no plans had been prepared for

the footpath through the village but he had asked
his Director Services to discuss this with the Clerk.
It was agreed to inform the Surveyor that the
footpath from the Brookside School was more important.

Decision took place on the use of Mr. Foreman's
Engineering Tools.

It was agreed that the next meeting of the Council
be held on Monday the 18th of November 1968.
