

Minutes of a Meeting of the Council held at the Women's Institute, Braishfield on Monday 22nd June, 1970
Present: Mr. C.H. Bartlam in the Chair, Miss D. Bacon & Messrs. A. Cobbold, D. Lowman, G. Parsons & H. Steiner.

Clerk

Mr. A. Cobbold proposed & Miss D. Bacon seconded that Mr. Andrew Lalonde of Apple Cottage, Braishfield, Romsey be elected Clerk to succeed the late Mr. Walter Gay. The motion was carried unanimously. The Chairman proposed & Mr. Steiner seconded that the Clerk should receive a salary of £30. This was also unanimously accepted.

These were signed by Miss D. Bacon & Messrs. A. Cobbold, D. Lowman, G. Parsons & H. Steiner. The Clerk witnessed the signatures.

Mr. Walter Gay

It was agreed that a sincere vote of thanks & great appreciation of the work carried out by the late Mr. Walter Gay since the inception of the Braishfield Parish Council be formally recorded in the minutes.

Footpath No. 2

The Chairman reported that the proposed deviation at Tegana Way

was not the concern of the Parish Council & was up to individual people.

Clearing through of Footpaths

The Clerk was instructed to write to the Romsey & Stockbridge Rural District Council regarding the clearing of the undergrowth in the footpaths in the village. Particular attention was to be made to the footpath from Kernhill to the Harley Road (Footpath No. 13).

Recreation Ground

It was agreed that the rough boundaries of the recreation ground should be tidied up. Mr. Parsons said he would deal with this.

Termyns Lane Crossroads

The Clerk was instructed to write to the Chairman of the Romsey Extra Parish Council to ask them if they could deal with the outgrowth of the hedges at the Blarishfield road & Termyns Lane crossroads.

Ditches

The Clerk was instructed to write to Mr. Plumb regarding the condition of the ditches bordering Church Lane flowing to the pond.

Finance

A cheque for 8/- was drawn & signed in favour of the Romsey
