

Minutes of the Meeting of the Braishfield Parish Council held at the Women's Institute Hall, Braishfield on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> March, 1971 at 8 p.m.

Minutes The Minutes of the meeting held on 1<sup>st</sup> February were read & approved.

#### Matters Arising

- (a) Mr. Parsons said that he had taken no action on repairs to the bus shelter.
- (b) Miss Bacon reported that the W.I. were getting on with arrangements for the seat.
- (c) With regard to the rods in the entrance & the pedestrian entrance at the Recreation Ground, it was decided that the Clerk should inspect with Mr. Parsons.
- (d) The Clerk reported that Mr. Attee had been in touch with him regarding the defunct Braishfield Horticultural Society. Mr. Attee had said that he thought it better if the notice in the press was inserted

after the annual Parish Meeting.  
The Council were not in favour  
of giving the money to the  
Romsey Horticultural Society. The  
Clerk was instructed to write  
to the Clerks of neighbouring  
Parish Councils to obtain their  
views.

- (e) With regard to ditches over-  
flowing in Church Lane, Miss

to inspect the whole route of  
the ditch.
