Matters Raised at the Annual Meeting.

- (i) The Clerk was instructed to obtain a further copy of the criteria relating to speed limits, & to send it to Mr. Norman Fielder.
- (ii) The Clerk said he would find out as much as he could about the sandpit & gravel pits in the village.
- (iii) The Clerk said he would find out from Mr. Michael Hodd inott whether or not he would be prepared to plant trees along the new road widening length of road.
- (iv) The Clerk was asked to write to the County Council & ask them

if they could erect a white at the entrance of the footpath to prevent horses riding up. The Clerk is also to write to the Hants Association of Parish Councils to find out how to go about preventing people riding horses along footpaths.

- (v) The Clerk was instructed to write to the Romsey Borough Council & find out if the building at present being done in Romsey would delay the main drainage of the village.

Recreation Ground.

The Chairman said that he thought the over hanging branches would have to be lopped as a result of the road widening. The Clerk was asked to arrange for the H.C.C. to do this.

The Clerk said that no more information was to hand regarding the Football Clubs new pavilion.

Any other Business

- (i) The Clerk was asked to write to the R.D.C. & find out the latest position regarding the dumping of industrial waste at Casbrook.

- (ii) The Clerk was instructed to ask Mr. Watkins to do something about the number of cars parked on the land in front of his house.
- (iii) The next meeting was arranged for Monday 7th May at 7.30 p.m.

There being no further business the Chairman closed the meeting.
