

Minutes of the Meeting of the
Braishfield Parish Council held on
Monday 7th May 1973 at the

Minutes. The Minutes of the Meeting
held on Monday 26th March
were read & approved.

Matters Arising

- (i) The Clerk reported that he
had received further copies
of the 'Speed Limit' criteria &
that he would send a copy
to Mr. Fielder.
- (ii) The Clerk reported that he had
heard from Mr. Lawrence. He
had said that there probably
was a right to gain sand for
non-commercial use, from the
sandpit at the rear of the
garage.
- (iii) The Clerk said he had spoken
to Mr. Michael Hoddinott who
regretted that he would not be
able to plant trees along the
Braishfield Road this year.
- (iv) The question of horse riding
in footpaths was considered by

the Council. The H.A.P.C. had written a long letter informing the Council that there was little the Council could do apart from asking landowners in question if they would permit stiles or posts at the entrances.

- (v) The Clerk reported that the Rousey Borough Sewerage Works were to be enlarged in about 18 months time to enable the Braishfield & Michelmerdy sewers to discharge there.
- (vi) The Clerk reported that the trees overhanging the footpath would be trimmed back initially by the H.C.C. This had in fact been done the day of the meeting.
- (vii) The Clerk read a letter from the R.D.C. regarding the industrial waste tipping at Casbrook. Planning permission had been granted but negotiations were still proceeding over the access.

Correspondence

- (i) The Clerk circulated the Parish Council review.
- (ii) The Clerk read a notice regarding an appeal by Mr. J. Saunders against the decision of H.C.C. to refuse him Planning Permission

adjacent to the Poplars. The Council were unanimously against this application and the Clerk was instructed to write accordingly.

- (iii) The Clerk reported that the Football Clubs wished to hold a fête on the Recreation Ground on 30th June. The Council gave their consent subject to the condition that they clear up all the litter.
