

Minutes of the meeting of the Braishfield Parish Council held on Monday 1st October 1973 at the Women's Institute at 7.30 hrs.

Present: A.E. Colebold in the Chair, Miss S.C.L. Bacon, Mrs J. Bell, S.B. Newman, J. Heine and Miss M. Heenan.

Apologies were received from C.H. Barkham and J.R.B. Brown.

Minutes of the meeting held on Monday 3rd September were read and approved.

Matters Arising.

(i) The Clerk showed the meeting more photographs of the planning infringement at Fox Wykes. It was decided to send 1/2 of each to the local planning authority.

(ii) The Clerk reported that he had asked Mr R.W. Dobby to proceed with the work of the fence outside the Recreation Ground.

(iii) The new pavilion in the recreation ground was discussed. The Clerk read letters that had been discussed at previous meetings so that everything was clear to everyone. It was decided that the Council would be prepared to give security on the pavilion for the loan from the Football Association.

It was decided that the Council should engage Mr J.B.S. Atlee to look after its affairs. On the question as to whether the Council could avoid V.A.T. it was reported that the authorities were still considering the matter.

The Council instructed the Clerk to ensure that there was adequate

arrangements for checkouts to use the toilets.  
The Council agreed that should the Recreation Ground  
ever be acquired then the Council would pay for  
the removal of the Pavilion to another recreation  
ground if one is provided.

(i) The Clerk advertised the report of the

Association.

(ii) The Clerk read a letter from Mr J. Bacon.  
The Council noted the planning applications being  
considered and the action to be taken.

### Any Other Business

(i) It was reported that the Football football was  
very overgrown and Clerk said he would look into  
it.

(ii) The Chairman reminded the meeting that the  
Football signs were still in the barn. It was  
decided that the Clerk should organise someone to  
do this.

(iii) Mrs Bell suggested that ~~the~~ a copy of
