

Minutes of the Meeting of the Braishfield Parish Council  
held on Monday 7th January 1974 at the Womens  
Institute at 7.30 P.M.

Apology was received from Mr. C. H. Barkham.

Minutes of the meeting held on Monday 5th November 1973 were  
read and allowed.

### Matters Arising:

(i) It was reported that the litter bins in the  
Recreation Ground had been repaired but that the new  
one had not been erected at school corner. The Clerk  
had heard nothing from the R.D.C.

(ii) The Clerk reported that he was trying to  
locate the O.S. plans showing footpaths in the  
parish.

(iii) The Clerk said he would get the footpath  
signs erected as soon as possible.

### Correspondence.

(i) The Clerk read a letter from the Romney  
Council asking a donation from Parish  
Funds. After discussion it was decided to  
leave the matter for consideration at the  
Annual Meeting.

(iv). A letter from the Romney and District Accident Prevention Council was read asking for a representative to attend their monthly meetings since no cancellor was prepared to go - it was decided that this should be raised at the Annual meeting.

### Pavilion on Recreation Ground.

This was discussed and the Clerk was asked to tell the RSO+ club that they must not drive across the Recreation Ground but behind the perimeter.

### Any other Business.

(a) It was decided to accept £500 to cover the outstanding expenses and to be paid for the year 1973/4 and also the grant of £407 to be paid to the RSO+ club for the pavilion.

(b) The question of whether main drainage was likely to be delayed because of local Government re-organisation was raised. Mr. Stann said that the plans should have been completed in the Autumn. There were 3 reasons why they had not — the 11.3.7 had meant that Climbath had to be severed — the extension of the Romney works had been slower than anticipated and local Government reorganisation. The Clerk was asked to find out the up-to-date position. Mr. Stann said that it was included in the estimates in the West Valley Authority capital account.

There being no further business the Vice-Chairman closed the meeting.
