

Minutes of the Bransfield Parish Council held on Monday  
6th May 1974 at the Women's Institute at 7.30 pm.

2) Minutes

village.

(ii) The Clerk had received a letter from the Police

using the road.

(iii) A letter from the T.V.E. saying that they would  
clear up the rubbish in the Recreation Ground.

(iv) The Clerk announced that the footpath signs would  
be erected by Mr J. Saunders.

(v) The Clerk reported that Mr J. Fahy would be  
the footpath representative.

4) Election of Officers.

(i) Miss Bacon proposed, and Mrs Bell seconded that  
Mr C.H. Barkham be elected as Chairman for the ensuing  
year.

(ii) Mr J.B. Lowman proposed, and Mr J. Skene  
seconded that Mr A. & Colbold be elected as vice  
Chairman.

The Clerk presented a draft lease for the 250+ club. The Council approved but the Clerk was asked to find out who owned the building and whether the Council could settle the gardeners' fee and that of the solicitor and increase the payment accordingly. It was noted that the grass had been mown.
