

BRAISHFIELD PARISH COUNCIL

Minutes of the meeting of the Braishfield Parish Council held at the Womens' Institute Hall, Braishfield on Monday, 10th December 1979, at 7.30 p.m.

Present: Mrs. B. M. Bell (Chairman), and Messrs. I. H. Chisholm, A. E. Cobbold, G. Shipton and J. A. Stewart. Mrs. J. Fahy (Footpaths Representative) was also in attendance.

101. MINUTES

Resolved that the minutes of the meeting held on 12th November 1979, and of the Special meeting held on 26th November 1979, be approved as correct records and signed by the Chairman.

102. TVS 2147/1 - PARKING OF MOBILE HOME ON SITE AT MERRIE MEAD FARM, BRAISHFIELD : MR. K. EMERY

Further to minute 97 (12.11.79) the Clerk submitted a letter dated 23rd November from the Chief Planning Officer setting out the Borough Council's position on this matter.

Resolved that the Chief Planning Officer be thanked for his most informative letter and advised that should a further application be submitted for residential development on this site, the Parish Council will reiterate its comments contained in minute 38(a) (20.8.79).

103. REFUSE DISPOSAL

With reference to minute 99 (12.11.79) the Clerk submitted a letter from the Chief Environmental Health Officer stating that it was quite possible that another tip might become available in the northern part of the Borough, thereby dispensing with the need to use the Bunny Lane tip for the disposal of refuse from that part of the Borough. He further gave an assurance that it was never intended that the refuse vehicles would be routed through Braishfield, but that they would be directed along the A.3057.

107. WATER SUPPLY TO VILLAGE

Further to minute 25 (9.7.79) the Clerk submitted a letter from the Southern Water Authority stating that the work was likely to commence at the end of November 1979 and continue until February 1980.

The Clerk also reported that the County Divisional Surveyor had given notice that part of Newport Lane would be temporarily closed from mid-January to enable main laying to take place.

108. SEPTIC TANK AND CESSPIT EMPTYING SERVICE

A letter, dated 14th November, from the Chief Technical Officer of the Borough Council was submitted setting out the new arrangements for the emptying of septic tanks in the Southern part of the Borough.

109. REORGANISATION OF POLICE BOUNDARIES

The Clerk submitted a letter, dated 7th December, from Hampshire Constabulary concerning some restructuring in police divisional boundaries with effect from 1st January 1980. Under the new structure the Romsey Police Sub-Division, which included Braishfield, would be transferred to the New Forest Police Division, Lyndhurst.

110. COUNCIL FOR THE PROTECTION OF RURAL ENGLAND - HAMPSHIRE BRANCH

Resolved that a subscription of £3 be paid to this organisation.

111. CLERK'S SALARY AND EXPENSES

Resolved that the Clerk's salary to date in the sum of £25 together with expenses in the sum of £2.56 be paid.

112. HIGHWAY MATTERS

The Clerk submitted three letters from the County Divisional Surveyor setting out the present position on matters referred to him.

In respect of broken road direction signs the Surveyor stated that he was unable to undertake repairs in the present financial climate.

Resolved that the Clerk enquire of the County Divisional Surveyor the cost of repairing the road direction signs with a view to the costs being met jointly by the County and Parish Councils.
