(a) TVS 974/3 - Proposed New Playroom and Utility Room - Clayhill, Braishfield: Mr. P. MacMillan

(b) TVS 2868 - Proposed Bar Extension, New Living Room and General Improvements - Newport Arms, Braishfield: G. Gale and Co. Ltd.

## Resolved: -

- (A) that, whilst the Parish Council is not opposed to the principle of this proposed development, the following comments be submitted to the Test Valley Borough Council:-
  - (i) there is insufficient car parking available for present needs at these premises and this opportunity must be taken to require an extension of the car park, especially as the proposed development is likely to increase the clientel, and steps should be taken to discourage roadside parking;
  - (ii) the proposed fenestrations in the north-east and south-east elevations should match the existing;
  - (iii) for safety reasons the access proposed in the north-east elevation should be relocated to the south-east elevation;
  - (iv) it would appear from the submitted plans that there is no access to bedroom number one.
- (B) that the Borough Council be asked to inform the Parish Council if it is intended to glaze the tax window, the size of which appears to be altered in the proposals submitted.
