84 MID TEST LOCAL PLAN

RESOLVED:

That the Parish Council concur with the view expressed by the Braishfield Village Association that input to the Mid Test Local Plan should be approached as a joint exercise between the two bodies, and that the means of achieving this be discussed at the next Annual Parish Meeting.

85 ANNUAL FLOWER SHOW

RESOLVED:

That approval be given to the holding of the Annual Flower Show on the Recreation Ground on 21st July 1984.

86 THE PLAZA, ROMSEY - APPEAL FUND

RESOLVED:

That the Romsey Amateur Operatic and Dramatic Society be advised that the Parish Council do not consider it appropriate that a contribution towards the purchase and refurbishment of the Plaza should be made from Parish Council funds as parishioners are able if they so wish to make contributions on an individual basis.

- (ii) That the Chairman be requested to investigate the feasibility of placing concrete slabs under the seats to eliminate the problems caused by the accumulation of mud.
