78. HIGHWAY MATTERS

The Chairman referred to extensive damage which had occured in Paines Hay Road as a result of surface water. The Clerk reported that he had already notified the Area Surveyor of the problem and Councillor Wyss had indicated that he would also pursue the matter on behalf of the Parish.

The Clerk reported the receipt of a letter from the Area Surveyor which indicated that he would reconsider the justification for introducing a speed limit through the village. The Area Surveyor also gave the up to date position on several other highway aspects in the Parish including the Jermyns Lane/Braishfield Road junction and the provision of bend warning signs.

Consideration was also given to notes on the criteria for imposing speed limits which had been obtained by the Village
