52. MINUTES

RESOLVED -

That the Minutes of the Meeting held on the 18 October 1990 be signed by the Chairman as a correct record.

53. PARISH TREE WARDEN SCHEME

It was reported that the Hampshire and Isle of Wight Naturalists Trust Limited had launched their Test Valley Parish Tree Warden Scheme on the 24th November 1990. Details of the scheme had been circulated to Parish Councils, It was hoped to promote volunteers giving advice and encouraging tree projects to be undertaken. It was agreed that posters and leaflets would be displayed on the noticeboard and at the Post Office.

54. PARISH ENVIRONMENT INITIATIVE

Reference was made to a new scheme by the Hampshire and Isle of Wight Naturalists Trust Ltd which would encourage and help Parishes and local groups to care for the environment. Posters and information about the scheme were distributed amongst members and reference was made to the possibility of the village pond being included in the scheme.

55. BRAISHFIELD VILLAGE HALL

A request was received from the Braishfield Village Hall Management Committee for financial assistance towards essential renovation work at

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the Hall. The work included external decorating and cleaning and amounted to £775.00. Other local groups had agreed to donate money to the project and the County Council had indicated that they would consider making a grant of not more than a third of the total cost.

RESOLVED -

That a sum of £200.00 be donated to the Village Hall Management Committee for this work.

56. TEST VALLEY BOROUGH PLAN

A copy of the draft Test Valley Borough Plan was received and details of the public consultation exercise reported. The proposals plan was circulated amongst members and any comments from individual members were to be reported to the parish council chairman prior to the 15 December, the closure date for objections. The draft plan did not propose any additional development for Braishfield apart from frontage development of a similar size and nature to existing dwellings.

57. HIGHWAY MATTERS

Reference was made to a letter from the Braishfield Village Assocation which outlined several ideas for improving road safety in the village. These included additional bend warning signs in the vicinity of Crook Hill; improvements to the road surface south of Crook Hill and new village signs welcoming careful drivers.

RESOLVED -

That the suggestions made by the Village Association be submitted to the County Council's Area Surveyor with a request that consideration be given for their implementation.

58. RECREATION GROUND

D Butterfield reported that he had arranged for a meeting to take place with P Wheeler a local contractor, concerning the provision of a safety surface in the play area.

RESOLVED -

That the position be noted and the Chairman and J Musselwhite also attend the meeting with Mr Wheeler.

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59. VILLAGE POND

T Howkins reported that he had met Nic Butler of the Hampshire and Isle of Wight's Naturlists Trust to discuss possible improvement work at the Village Pond. It was hoped that the Trust would be able to indicate the likelihood of any assistance to the Parish Council following a further meeting with Mr Howkins together with the Chairman and Vice-Chairman.

NOTES

- A sum of £1500 has been earmarked in the current year for the refurbishing of the play area. This is made up of a sum of £750 allocated but not spent last year together with a similar amount provided from this years budget.
