55. MINUTES

RESOLVED -

That the minutes of the meeting held on 21st October, 1993 be signed by the Chairman as a correct record.

56. PLANNING APPLICATIONS

(a) Primary School Redevelopment

Reference was made to applications for the above development from the County Council in addition to the Borough Council. Comments had already been sent to Test Valley Borough Council about the applications and it was agreed that these also be forwarded to the County Planning Officer.

(b) TVS 1254/2 Annex at Oak Tree Cottage, Common Hill Road.

RESOLVED -

That the Borough Council be informed of the Parish Council's concern at this development on the following grounds:

- 1) The accommodation proposed includes an office but no kitchen facilities which implies that the development could be used for commercial and not residential purposes and
- 2) That the development would generate additional traffic negotiating the entrance to Oak Tree Cottage which is opposite the local school and could affect child road safety.

57. DIAL-A-RIDE SCHEME

A request for financial assistance was received from this voluntary service who were incurring additional expenses fitting safety belts to their vehicles. A grant of £50 had been made to the organisation in February 1993.

RESOLVED -

That a contribution of £50 be made to the Southern Test Valley Voluntary Transport Scheme under Section of the Local Government Act 1972.

58. RECYCLING

Reference was made to a press release from Test Valley Borough Council confirming that all material collected by them was recycled and not dumped in landfilled sites as suggested by recent television programmes.

RESOLVED -

That the position be noted.

59. HIGHWAYS

The Chairman confirmed that arrangements had been made for a meeting with the Area Surveyor on 29th November at 2.30 pm.

60. ALL SAINTS CHURCH CLOCK 7/5/93

Reference was made to the project to repair the church clock which had been undertaken by the Braishfield Church Council. Works had now been completed in the sum of £1930 and paid for by the Parish Council. These costs however would be offset by a grant of £643 from Test Valley Borough Council, a contribution of £643 from the Church Council and a contribution of £250 from the Braishfield Village Association. The net cost to the Parish Council would be £393.

RESOLVED -

That the position be noted.

61. BOROUGH COUNCILLOR'S REPORT

Councillor Wyss attended the meeting and reported on current matters affecting the Borough Council which included the Borough Council's consideration of a planning application from Tesco for a supermarket on land adjoining the bypass at Romsey.
