Test Valley Borough Council

a) **22/01699/FULLS Woolley Green Farm, Dores Lane, Braishfield**

**OBJECTION with the following comments:**

- This access is claimed by the applicant to be capable of farm use without modification and to have existed for at least 40 years, but has not been used for at least 10 years. The Council's understanding, from councillors own local knowledge over the period of over 40 years, is that the track has not been used throughout this period.
- Sightlines - the lane is very narrow, dark and sunken with high banks with extensive tree growth obscuring the entrance which is located on the inside of a blind bend.
- Highways Safety - should a vehicle be turning out of the entrance (likely to be a large farm vehicle) there would be no where for oncoming traffic to go to avoid a collision. In Winter, this stretch of road is often icy, adding to the danger. The route has become very popular with cyclists and walkers.
