# 22/03217/OUTS and 22/03218/OUTS

The Council resolved to **OBJECT** to both applications. The following issues were raised and issues were raised to form the basis of the objection.

- 1. The application form in respect of the northern plot had not been reproduced on the TVBC website. This made it difficult to formulate an objection, and called into question whether the consultation period could properly be said to have commenced.
- 2. If the missing application form was in similar form to that for the corner plot, it sought approval for a detached dwelling, but including approval of access, size and layout. The vertical size of the proposed dwelling was not apparent from the plans or the application form, but the supplementary information included a reference to a 4-bedroom house on each plot. These factors go beyond normal outline applications, and might justify inclusion in the objection of references to provisions in the Village Design Statement which might go by default if the permission was granted as sought.
- 3. Parishioners raised a number of such issues, including domination of adjoining houses, being out of character with the surrounding landscape and overlooking/loss of privacy.
- 4. The vehicle access to both plots was unsatisfactory.
- 5. The development might be said to contravene the established building line, and to constitute backland development.
- 6. The circumstances and the extent of the permission sought pointed to the suggestion that TVBC should be encouraged to insist on a full application at this stage, so that the issues which the application had raised could be fully considered.

The Council disapproved of Aster Homes, as a provider of affordable homes, selling these plots for open market development instead of providing affordable homes in Braishfield.
