Alli the emembers of the Council have been regular attendants at the Meetings of the Council.

Again many matters have been considered by the Council and I will report on them as they arose. Housing on the Post Office site was press for and after

several plans had been discussed it was decided that three dwellings should be built on the Post Office Site and three on the Chapel site and these dwellings are now nearing completion. The older houses are to be modernised. Parish Councils association. Mr. Parsons and Mr. Cobbold have attended Meetings of this Association as the Councils representatives.

A Policy Statement was made by the County Footpaths Council during the year and Mr. Newberry of the County Council attended one of the Councils Meetings and explained the Policy to the Council.
