Copy of a report to be made to the Annual Parish Meeting to be held at the Women's Institute, Braishfield on Wednesday 31st March, 1965 at 8.0. p.m.

Mr. I. T. Robinson was re-elected Chairman and Mr. A. H. Cobbold Vice-Chairman for the ensuing year. Mr. ~~Robinson~~ and Mr. Cobbold were appointed representatives on the Parish Council Association. ~~Mrs~~ Bacon and Mr. Cobbold were appointed Managers of the Braishfield Primary School. Mr. J. Horstnot resigned from the Council owing to ill health.

Regular meetings of the Council have been held and most members have 100% attendances. Mr. Brown, the County Council and District Council representative, has also been a regular attender and the Council was grateful for his help and co-operation.

Roads and Footpaths

The thanks of the Council are again due to the Divisional Surveyor for his help with regard to the roads and verges. It has been noted how much better the verges have been kept during the past year. The improvement at Brookhill has been carried out and the improvement at Crookbridge completed.

Recreation Ground

The County Council has again made a contribution of £10 for use of the ground by the school and arrangements have been made with the County Council to ~~keep the ground out for one year.~~ Posts were put into the gaps in the hedge to save the children running directly onto the road but these were destroyed the day they were put in. Further fencing was carried out during the year.

Planning Application and Housing matters have been brought before the Council by Mr. Brown and the help of the Council in selecting new tenants.

More damage has been done to the bus shelter and it was agreed to carry out certain repairs and have the commemorative plaque re-written and replaced in the shelter.

A contested election was held in the Parish and the expense of this election came to 31 17s. 9d.

The rateable value of the Parish is £14,651 and the product of a 1d. rate - 60.

A short meeting of the Parish Council will be held after the Parish Meeting.
