Mr. I.T. Robinson was re-elected Chairman and Mr. A.H. Cobbold Vice-Chairman for the ensuing year and the composition of the Council has remained the same.

The attendance at Council Meetings has been most regular and Mr. Brown the County Council and District Council representative has attended and been most helpful and his help is much appreciated with regard to County Council, District Council and Planning Matters.

Roads and Footpaths

The Divisional Surveyor has dealt with the complaints and suggestions received and our thanks are due to the speedy and helpful way these complaints have received attention. The improvement in the sight line at Kilm Lane being much appreciated.

Recreation Ground :-

The Recreation ground has been much improved by the constant cutting of the grass but this service has cost the Council £33 for the year. The Grant from the County Council of £10 has been continued and it is hoped this will be increased in the coming year although the rate for cutting the grass will be increased from 27/6d. to 32/6d. per hour.

Our grateful thanks are due to Miss Bacon for her generosity in supplying and erecting a new fence on the roadside of the Recreation Ground.

Consideration has also been given to the withdrawal of the Social Club from the premises on the Recreation Ground when their new premises are completed.

Bus Services :

Several times during the year the Council has consulted the Bus Company with regard to alterations in the Service and obtained improvements.

The Rateable Value of the Parish is £14440. 0. 0d. and the Product of the 1d. rate is £60. 0. 0d.

A meeting of the Parish Council will be held after the Parish Meeting.
