Copy of a Report to be made to the Annual Parish Meeting to be held at the Womens Institute Braishfield on Monday the 6th March, 1967 at 8 p.m.

Mr. Robinson was re-elected Chairman and Mr. Cobbold Vice Chairman for the Year and the Membership of the Council remained the same.

Mr. Brown the County Council and District Council representative has attended most of the Meetings of the Council and the Council is most grateful for the information and help he has been able to give.

Recreation Ground. After much thought and discussion the old Club Premises have been demolished and the site has been cleared. It is hoped that this site will be used as a Car Park for the Recreation Ground.

Vandalism caused damage to the new Fence erected last year and rate money has had to be used to effect repairs.

The Ground continues to be used by the School for sports purposes and because of the cost of maintaining the Ground the County Council has agreed to increase its contribution to £ 25 a year.

It was decided that all the Meetings of the Council should in future be held at the Womens Institute at a cost of £ 4 per year.

Many matters have been taken up with the Divisional Surveyor and his help and cooperation has resulted in many improvements especially with hedging and ditching.

Representatives of the Council have attended the Meetings of the newly reformed Parish Councils Association.

The Rateable Value at the 1st April will be £ 15, 983 and the Product of the 1/6 Rate £ 65.

A Short Meeting of the Parish Council will follow the Annual Parish Meeting.
