Report of Braishfield Annual Parish Meeting held at the Village Hall, Braishfield on Monday 11th April 1983.

## PRESENT:

Parish Councillors G. Shipton(Chairman); Mrs. B.M. Bell, Messrs. I.H. Chisholm, J.A. Stewart, P. Watkins and R. Corry (District Council representative) and eleven parishioners.

- (a) The Chairman opened the meeting by welcoming those present.
- (b) Col. T. Fitzgibbon of Broughton gave a talk on the Broughton and Mottisfont Community Bus scheme.
- (c) The reports of the Clerk, and the Footpaths Representative were submitted.
- (d) Concern was expressed at the proposed withdrawal of free transport facilities for some Braishfield schoolchildren and it was agreed that the matter should be discussed in detail at the next ordinary meeting of the Parish Council.
- (e) The meeting discussed in general terms the need to safeguard the future of buildings of historic and architectural interest in the village.
- (f) The parishioners present raised no objection to the proposal of the Village Hall Management Committee to include among the conditions relating to the hire of the Hall, a requirement that all events finish by midnight save in exceptional circumstances as may be identified by the Parish Council.
- (g) The Chairman expressed the gratitude of the Parish Council to Mr. R. Corry who was retiring as Borough Council representative on the Parish Council, for the latter's valuable contribution to the work of the Council.
