Report of the Braishfield Annual Parish Meeting held at the Village Hall, Braishfield on Monday, 9th April, 1984.

Present: P. Watkins (Chairman); Miss P. Saunders; G. Shipton; J. A. Stewart and Councillor J. Wyss (Borough Council representative), together with 35 residents.

- (a) The Chairman opened the meeting by welcoming those present.
- (b) The reports of the Clerk and the Footpath Representative were submitted.
- (c) The present position in respect of the refurbishment of the village pond was outlined and it was agreed that the Clerk should make application for grant aid to Hampshire County Council in addition to Test Valley Borough Council.
- (d) Discussion took place on the Mid Test Local Plan and various opinions expressed on relevant matters, notably Esidential development.
- (e) The desirability of a speed limit being imposed on the main road through the village was mentioned. It was recognised, however, that the likelihood of an application for the sign being successful was somewhat remote as current criteria stood. It was, therefore, agreed that instead the Parish Council should discuss at their next meeting the possibility of a "Please drive slowly through the village" sign being erected.
